H. R. 218

The Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act (LEOSA), often referred to as HR 218, allows qualified Law Enforcement officers (LEOs) and qualified retired LEOs (RLEOs) to concealed carry in any jurisdiction in the United States, regardless of state or local laws, with some exceptions.

There is a nominal fee to participate in the HR218 shoot. It is paid at the time of registration.



SOLUTIONS TO STRESS FROM TRAUMATIC INCIDENTS

While we rarely question physical injuries or even a diagnosis on medical ailments, the disabling effects of former job-related trauma or something recently experienced are not readily visible. Having a traumatic reaction, or the fear of even acknowledging a traumatic reaction, is somehow seen as weakness. We need to accept that a reaction may occur and seek the necessary help when it does. It is not uncommon for former protective service personnel to have sleep disorders. Typically, most people are at a loss for words after something a person they know is experiencing in reference to trauma. We tend to say the wrong things or become too intrusive in our comments. Unfortunately, the person subjected to such trauma may avoid talking about it simply for fear that others will become annoyed, so they abstain from revealing their true pain. Routinely, those affected may lean on someone too much while repeatedly expressing their pain or the side effects of misery. This generally can force a person from wanting to talk with them at all.

Post-Traumatic Stress

Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) is defined by the diagnostic and statistical Manual of Mental Disorders as the development of specific characteristics after being exposed to a traumatic stressor. It is not designed to be a self-diagnosis used as an excuse for poor behavior. It was often referred to as "shell shock" in the world wars and the mechanisms for treatment were less sensitive than today. PTSD occurs from direct exposure to an event that involves actually or threatened death or serious injury, or witnessing such an egregious event with another. Symptoms develop due to an inability to adapt to the event and the event, regardless of the type of severity, overwhelms an individual's ability to cope. Without proper preventative measures and post incident intervention or support, the risks of worsening increase exponentially. Following traumatic incidents there are likely noticeable issues such as the inability to sleep, triggers that induce anger, disturbing memories that create anxiety, inability to concentrate, and emotional numbing. Without proper support, those affected will often turn to maladaptive coping mechanisms such as alcohol, drugs, or disengage from reality.

Positive Preventative Steps

Essentially, we should be caring for each other as a group especially with our consistent titled term of family as a motto. If we know that someone was exposed to a critical incident or currently is diagnosed with PTSD exposure to a critical incident, we need to develop a system to check on them. Most of the time we think we know what PTSD consists of because we read the definition. Trust me, there is more to this than just what you read.

Maybe we need to be more proactive and implement preventative techniques to minimize the potential for long-term stress disorders and develop procedures within Blue Knights internationally that are consistent.

Periodic articles or training will allow for more accurate assessments to understand the signs displayed or to understand proper vocabulary and proper words of comfort. To avoid trigger phrases or making incorrect evaluations. One of the biggest issues for those finding a support person is that the person they choose often believes they have been ordained to give advice. Sometimes the advice given is not from someone with an educational understanding but just from their perspective and may worsen the situation. It is perfectly acceptable that when someone talks to you about trauma, they are just looking for a way to vent and your advice is unnecessary.

External scars are still more accepted than those deep within.

This is a mere excerpt from an article I wrote for an international law enforcement magazine in December 2012.

My dissertation for my master's degree was on PTSD.




