Acceleration and Deceleration

Acceleration simply means the vehicle is increasing speed.

Deceleration means the vehicle is slowing down (braking or just reducing throttle).

In group riding, those two ideas become extremely important.

When a lead vehicle slows down even briefly — say by 20 mph — that slowdown sends a wave of braking backward through traffic. Two miles back, that same ripple can cause traffic to completely stop, even though there may be no danger or obstruction left at all. This is the “slinky effect.” We often notice this on I75 when traffic forcefully slows and a few miles down the road it is back to normal speed. That is likely the actions of a few that start the ripple effect.

The same principle applies to motorcycle groups.

Applying acceleration physics to group riding

Acceleration is expressed in meters per second squared (m/s^2).
Or, more commonly in riding terms: 0–60 mph time.

Most motorcycles average around 2.6 seconds from 0–60 mph.
This is an acceleration rate of about $10.32 m/s^2$.

Here's where that matters:

When the lead motorcycle slows down for an obstacle or corner and then accelerates hard afterward reaching 60 mph (88 feet per second) within a few seconds, the trailing bike is still arriving at the slow point, often without the ability to accelerate for 15–20 seconds later.

This means the lead rider is already long gone while the trailing rider is still recovering from the slowdown.

Using actual physics:

If the trail rider has to make up 15–20 seconds of lost distance, and only accelerates normally, they cannot catch up in a reasonable distance unless they reach very high speeds.

At a 15th second gap, the trailing rider may need to accelerate up to 90 mph just to catch the lead motorcycle within one mile — something we calculated in your earlier example.

Why this matters for group leaders

This is why it is critical for the lead motorcycle to:

- accelerate smoothly
- allow the group to regroup after corners or obstacles
- avoid “launching” after a slowdown

If the lead rider accelerates too aggressively, the group stretches out, riders start speeding to catch up, and safety decreases for everyone.

Good leadership means maintaining predictable, gentle acceleration so the entire group stays connected and relaxed instead of stretched and stressed.

Rodney P Stearns was a crash investigator in the military and following that as a deputy in his early years on patrol became a crash reconstructionist and ACTAR certified #691. He spent several years investigating fatal crashes, teaching crash investigations, and supervising crash experts.

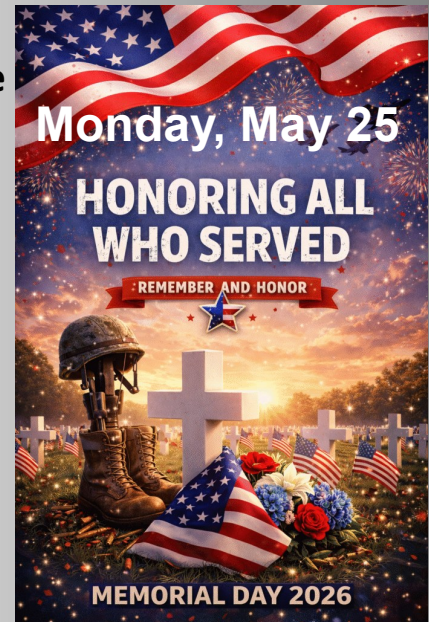

Memorial Day History

Memorial Day is dedicated to honoring and remembering the men and women who have sacrificed their lives in service to the country. The occasion serves to recognize the bravery and dedication of these individuals in all branches of the military, from the Army, Navy, and Marine Corps, to the Air Force and Coast Guard. The observance is also significant for fostering shared values of patriotism, commitment and respect for the armed forces among all Americans.

The inception of Memorial Day dates back to the aftermath of the Civil War in the late 19th century as a means to honor the soldiers who fell on both sides of the conflict. Originally known as Decoration Day, the holiday gained official recognition at the national level in 1971. Memorial Day is an important part of American society and culture because it provides a moment of collective remembrance for the country's fallen heroes. It's an opportunity for Americans to express their gratitude for the sacrifices made for the nation's freedom and security.

Memorial Day in the United States is marked by a variety of commemorative activities and traditions. These include visiting military cemeteries and memorials to lay flowers and flags, participating in parades, and observing a moment of silence or listening to 'Taps', a traditional bugle call played at military funerals. Many Americans also gather for family picnics and barbecues on this day, recognizing it as the unofficial start of the summer season. The Memorial Day National Moment of Remembrance, established by Congress, takes place at 3:00 pm local time. - The red poppy flower became a symbol of remembrance after the publication of the famous war poem "In Flanders Fields" by Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae.
- There have been about 1.35 million US military deaths since 1775.
- The deadliest war the U.S has participated in was the Civil War, with around 620,000 deaths.

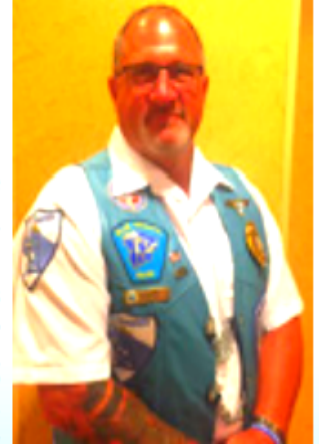

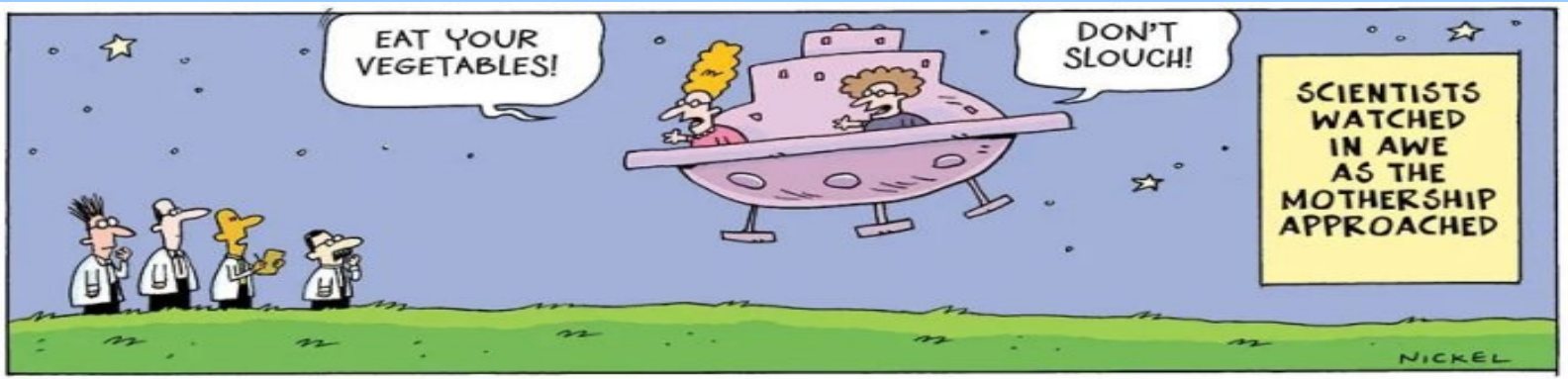
