Safety Tips.

Group riding.



All motorcycle clubs no matter how large or how small will at some point ride together in a group. Whether it is 20 motorcycles or 1000 motorcycles, safety for everyone should be a concern for all participates.

Every rider should be aware of not only their surroundings but, the riders in front of them. Riding in a group in an urban area is very different than riding out on the open road.

Perception/reaction at low speed, perception/reaction at high speed. The average perception/reaction for someone in good health and no distractions is 1.5 seconds. Add increased age and distractions and this time/distance increases.

At 35 miles per hour (urban riding), your vehicle is traveling at 51.31 feet per second so the time you perceive an event and react to it, you have traveled 76.96 feet.

At 60 miles per hour (highway riding), your vehicle is traveling at 87.96 feet per second so the time you perceive an event and react to it, you have traveled 131.94 feet.

We all want to enjoy the ride so let's make sure we all get to our destinations safely.
