MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Greetings Fellow Knights,

Busy month is ahead for our chapter with Thunder By The Bay February 13th, 14th, 15th. We will have a work event on Thursday the 12th to move our trailer to the fairgrounds and set up our booth. Please save the dates and come out and help.

On January 10th, I made a public service announcement on our chapter Facebook page about motorcycle safety. Subsequently, I was involved in a motorcycle accident. Both my brother in-law and I were hit from behind while we were waiting for a light to change. The Snowbird senior woman's foot slipped off her brake and nailed the gas and she crashed into both of us. Both my sister and girlfriend went flying off the bikes. Both had on full face helmets, both hit the pavement with their heads. They were taken to the hospital in a lot of pain and could not move. My sister has broken ribs and Geri was bruised up and in a lot of pain. My brother in-law and I were fine just sore. My bike was a total loss, we are waiting to hear on his. The bikes were Goldwings. I am glad we had such a big heavy bike to cushion the blow.

I have been riding for over thirty five years accident free... Can't say that anymore! I was told when I started riding that its not IF you have a motorcycle accident but WHEN you have a motorcycle accident. I have always tried to be a safe rider but like all of us I have done some stupid moves over the years. I have had some very close calls but always came out being blessed. I came out being blessed because for the life of me I don't know how I made it out of the situation. I'm sure you all can relate. God is good!

Now on to the safety part.. PLEASE, not for me but for everyone else who loves you put on a helmet. Get a good one that fits (DOT) not a skid lid. We were stopped with a long line of cars behind us I was still ready to move out hand on clutch, in gear, hand on brake ready to go. Only problem I had no warning just a revving sound and crunch. I went up off my feet the rear of the bike off the ground. The car was not going fast at all! Yet both passengers went flying off and both had helmet impact with the pavement. This could have been worse BUT THE HELMETS WORKED!!

I always use full gloves, long pants, motorcycle boots/hightop motorcycle sneaker, I have a few jackets with armor that I try to use; however, I have been a real slacker with the Florida heat and sometimes its just my vest and UV sleeves. I will try to do better.

One reason I became a Blue Knight was the promotion of safety among members not only for the chapter but for the public to observe and learn. Anyone who has rode with us, passengers included usually say they feel safe riding in the pack. Our brothers and sister knights will remind you of safety, they will tell you when you need to do better and help you to become a better motorcyclist. Our Blue Knight family strives to provided safe rides using hand signals, communication units, and common sense. We have a safety team on many levels in this origination and over the years I have learned from them and the wisdom they share.

We can be the best motorcyclist / Moto Man in the world, you can have all the gear, flashing lights, High Vis items. You can follow every safety move and procedure but we have no control over others behind the wheel. Give yourself a fighting chance. Think back to the job and the armor and tools you had to help you each and every day. Hot, heavy and uncomfortable its not that different. If you are reading this the hot heavy equipment must have worked.





As January ends and February begin, we began to think about Valentines Day and our loved ones. Especially remembering Blue Knight Brothers that have entered “Haven One”. Let our thoughts and prayers this month include those Blue Knight Brothers, that dwell with our lord above. Keeping the heavens safe and patiently waiting to greet us when it is our time to dwell with the Lord and begin our next tour.

So how does Valentines connect to our religious beliefs and Jesus.

How Valentine's Day Connects to Jesus

Even though Valentine's Day today is wrapped in romance, chocolate, and roses, its roots point back to Christian history.

1. St. Valentine was a Christian martyr

The holiday is named after one (or possibly several) early Christian figures named Valentine who were executed for their faith. Their commitment is often framed as an expression of Christ like love — sacrificial, steadfast, and countercultural.

2. Christian theology centers on love

Jesus' teachings revolve around love in a way that fits surprisingly well with the themes of Valentine's Day:

- † “Love one another as I have loved you.”
- † “Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.”
- † Those ideas go far beyond romance — they're about compassion, loyalty, and self giving.

3. Some people use Valentine's Day to reflect on divine love. For many Christians, the day becomes a reminder of:

- † God's unconditional love
- † The idea of loving others well
- † Gratitude for relationships and community
- † It's a softer, more reflective angle than the commercial version of the holiday.






