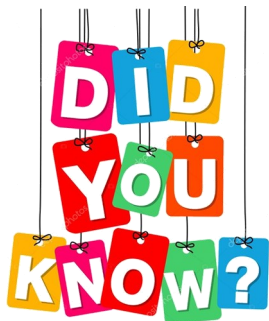

Armed security that protects students and staff at an assigned school. The main function of a guardian is to stop and abate an active shooter situation. The program looks for experienced security personnel usually retired law enforcement / military background as a priority. The schedule follows that same as teacher, 196 workdays a year, with summers off, Thanksgiving week off, two week Christmas break and One week for Spring Break.

THE MIXED BLESSING OF COOLER TEMPERATURES IN FLORIDA

The weather for motorcycle riding has finally shifted to our benefit, thank goodness! However, there is another side to consider with this blessing. The cooler temperatures will bring out many more motorcyclists than we see during the hot/humid weather and an increase in the number of four wheeled vehicles on our roads from the winter transient population.

According to an article in the Florida Realty Marketplace Blog [<https://www.floridarealtymarketplace.com/blog/10-surprising-statistics-on-snowbirds-in-florida-for-2023.html>]. There are about one million people who spend at least one month in Florida mainly between October and April. This translates into an increase in the local population of about 5% for all of Florida with Sarasota, Clearwater, Fort Myers, and Cape Coral being on the list of the top ten destinations giving the southwest coast of Florida a good portion of the winter resident influx. Of course, there are also the visiting tourists

All total; this increases the amount of traffic we will be dealing with during the next few months. There are multiple sources which discuss motorcycle accidents and their causes with one hazard consistently cited as the most significant, a driver not seeing the motorcycle. The reason given is that they just did not see the motorcycle, which I am sure is true. However, I had people pull out in front of me when I drove a truck for North American Van Lines for a summer. If they did not see the big white semi-truck coming at them what chance does a motorcycle have with inattentive and impatient folks? I now watch the tires of cars poised to make the jump into traffic and not the driver. If the tires start to roll, it is time to take evasive action.

Florida's cooler temperatures are a true blessing. But they also bring the need to be extra vigilant.

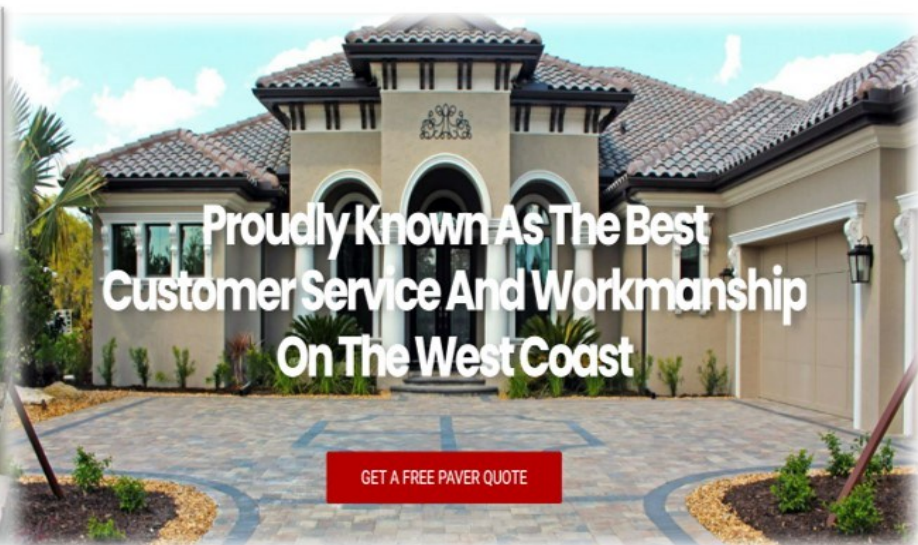

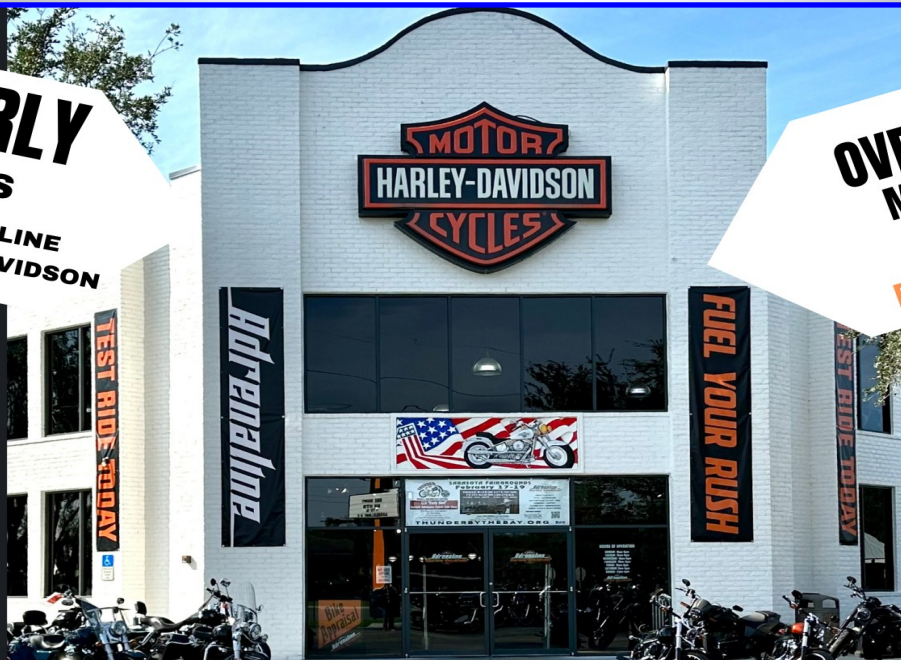
