



Many of us that served our community as first responders, still stay connected with fellow co-workers through the various organizations. As a retiree from the Baltimore Police Department, I stay connected with former colleagues through "The Baltimore Retired Police Benevolent Association".



This brings me to the point of my article this month and the inspiration that comes to be through connection with my law enforcement family. While the connection is great, there is also the pain of being notified that a former colleague has passed away, way too young. I can personally say that over the last few years, I have lost colleagues that were in their 50's and early 60's. The work of the first responders seemed to have a direct impact on our longevity time on this earth. I saw this post from Officer Brad Philip that fits most of your careers as law enforcement officers.

"My head hurts from being pummeled repeatedly with rocks. My arms and torso ache from taking direct hits from water bottles flung at us. My shin

hurts from a tear gas canister that someone threw back at us. My back hurts from having to wear riot gear for 7 hours on top of my normal 30 extra pounds of gear. I vomited for 10 minutes into a toilet when I got home this morning. My sense of dignity is hurt by the unspeakable things that were said to my brothers and sisters in blue who happen to be black. My sense of family is hurt by the unspeakable things that were said to us about our own children, parents, and siblings. And my heart breaks for the city that I love. I know my city is hurting right now. I know people are angry and want answers. But there's only one way we can move forward together, right now: love. Lots and lots of love. Connect. Respect. Protect. And Love. Time to go keep the peace." - Ofc. Brad Philip, Public Facebook Post, 9/21/16 As first responders your faithful service helped create peace in the world and now it is time to create peace within yourself. Studies have shown that there is a positive association between religious participation and happiness and civic engagement. The relationship between religion and health is very complex. Some studies have found positive associations between religion and health, such as how Americans who regularly attend religious services tend to live longer. I believe that the positive impact of religious beliefs can be associated with better mental health, including lower rates of depression, anxiety, substance use disorder, and suicidal behavior. If you haven't already, I strongly encourage our Blue Knight membership to seek that personal relationship with our Lord. Attending a local church and feeling the spirit of worship grow within you can bring the peace and harmony you deserve at this juncture of your life. May peace be with you always.



If you have one of those motorcycle helmets with the built-in headset for your phone, Florida law says you can use it for communication while riding. Legally you cannot use headphones to listen to music while riding your motorcycle. Keep in mind that the headset should only provide sound through one ear. Two-ear helmet headsets are forbidden. Listening devices that prevent you from hearing surrounding noise cannot be worn while riding a motorcycle in Florida. Wearing an earpiece connected to your cell phone would not violate the law as long as one ear is available to hear other sounds around you.




