The local children, Veterans, and Law Enforcement organizations are counting on you to sell all 1000 tickets so they can keep on receiving the support we provide.


The prices for the tickets are \$10 dollars per ticket and a book of 5 is \$30, THAT'S TWO FREE TICKETS !!!!

The program looks for experienced security personnel usually retired law enforcement / military background as a priority. The schedule follows that same as teacher, 196 workdays a year, with summers off, Thanksgiving week off, two week Christmas break and One week for Spring Break. Participants in the Florida (FRS) Retirement System, where you are vested after 8 years of service.



RELIGION AND MOTORCYCLE CLUBS: AN UNLIKELY INTERSECTION OF FAITH AND BROTHERHOOD

At first glance, religion and motorcycle clubs might seem like two worlds that could never intertwine. On one hand, religion often emphasizes faith, compassion, and spiritual growth. On the other, motorcycle clubs (MCs) are often stereotyped as rough, rebellious, and non-conformist. However, a closer look reveals an intriguing intersection where faith and the biker lifestyle blend into unique expressions of brotherhood, community, and purpose.

The Roots of Both Worlds

These organizations often participate in charity rides, outreach programs, and other activities aimed at spreading their faith while also embracing the open-road spirit.

These clubs offer members a way to reconcile their love of motorcycles with their spiritual beliefs. Riders gather not only for long-distance trips but also for prayer, Bible studies, or community service projects. The motorcycle becomes a tool for ministry, allowing members to connect with individuals who might not be reached through traditional religious methods.

Brotherhood Beyond Belief

While faith-based clubs have a clear religious foundation, spirituality can also be found in secular motorcycle clubs. The bond between riders often takes on a spiritual dimension, even in non-religious settings. The act of riding itself—experiencing the open road, the natural world, and the freedom of movement—can feel meditative and transcendent.

In some cases, secular clubs may include members from various religious backgrounds, fostering a unique environment of mutual respect and understanding. These clubs may not preach a specific doctrine, but they often embody values like mutual aid, perseverance, and respect—principles found in many religious teachings.

Common Misconceptions

One of the biggest misconceptions is that motorcycle clubs are inherently antagonistic toward religion or mainstream society. While some clubs do embrace an outlaw image, many prioritize community-building, charitable work, and personal growth. Similarly, not all faith-based motorcycle groups are rigid or judgmental; they often focus on meeting people where they are, offering friendship and support without pushing an agenda.

Bridging the Gap

The intersection of religion and motorcycle clubs highlights a universal truth: people seek connection, purpose, and freedom. Whether through faith, the open road, or a combination of both, these communities offer their members a sense of belonging and identity.

For religious individuals, joining or forming a motorcycle club allows them to integrate their spiritual beliefs with their lifestyle. For secular bikers, the bonds of brotherhood and the shared experiences of the road often take on a spiritual significance of their own.

" Doesn't matter what you give me, I'm just gonna use it as a hammer anyway."




