BEWARE OF SCAMMERS

Scammers goals are to get your personal information and money. Their strategies constantly change with the times. Fraudsters know people are most vulnerable when they're desperate or scared, and they may use crises and pressure tactics to prey on their victims.

Here are a few basic security measures that can help protect you from the latest and most common scams:

- Be skeptical when someone contacts you. Scammers can spoof calls and emails to make it look like they are coming from different sources, including government agencies, charities, banks and large companies. Don't share personal information, usernames, passwords or one-time codes that others can use to access your accounts or steal your identity.
- Enable multi-factor authentication.
- <u>Research companies before you make a purchase or donations.</u> Do a web search for its name plus "scam" or "reviews" and research charities on <u>Charity Navigator</u> and <u>Charity Watch</u>.
- Be careful with your phone. If you suspect a spam call, don't respond or press a button. The safest option is to hang up or ignore the call entirely.
- <u>Don't refund or forward overpayments</u>. Be careful whenever a company or person asks you to refund or forward part of a payment. Often, the original payment will be fraudulent and taken back later.
- <u>Look for suspicious payment requirements</u>. Scammers often ask for payments via <u>wire transfer</u>, <u>money order</u>, crypto currency or gift cards. These payments can be harder to track and cancel than other forms of payment, which can leave you stuck w without recourse.

If you're the victim of a scam, you can <u>file a report with the FTC</u> and your local law enforcement. The report may help others avoid similar scams.


